

ORDINANCE NO. 348

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF SKATEBOARDS, ROLLERBLADES, AND ROLLERSKATES WITHIN THE CITY OF BEULAH, MERCER COUNTY, NORTH DAKOTA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEULAH, MERCER COUNTY, NORTH DAKOTA. AS FOLLOWS:

1. INTENTION

Section 1. It is the intention of this ordinance to partially regulate the use of skateboards, rollerblades, and rollerskates within the jurisdiction of the City of Beulah, North Dakota.

2. PROHIBITION WHEN SIGNED

A person may not ride skateboard, rollerblades, or rollerskates on any public or private property, including streets and sidewalks, when said property is signed to prohibit those activities.

3. YIELD OF RIGHT-OF-WAY

Whenever any person is riding a skateboard, rollerblades, or rollerskates upon a sidewalk, or other public property, such persons shall yield the right-of-way to pedestrians and to all other traffic.

4. PENALTY

Any person violating this ordinance shall be subject to a fine not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).

5. SEVERABILITY

If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a decision of any court

of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

6. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect following final passage and adoption.
